**Please drop off your passengers on Front Street alongside The Mill & Mill Shed.**

Watch for signs to direct you to designated areas. Just beyond the drop off area are 4 designated parking spots for motorcoaches. If these are full, proceed to additional bus parking available at the rear of the municipal parking lot off Albert Street.

- Short stroll to retail stores & attractions along Front and King Street, and the many shops and exhibits in The Mill


